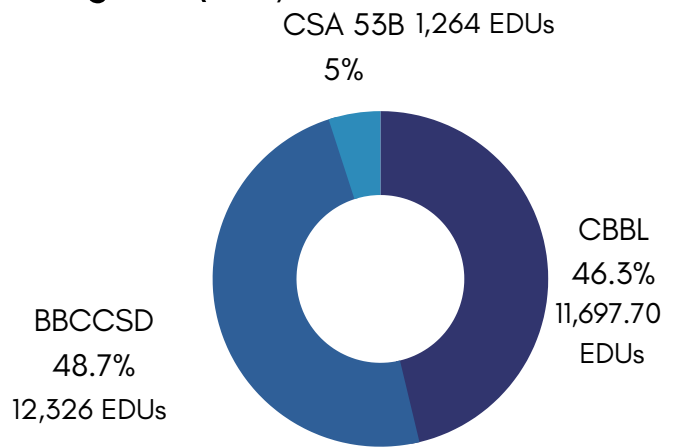
## SEWER USER RATES

EFFECTIVE

JUNE 30, 2023

Our three member agencies are the City of Big Bear Lake (CBBL), the Big Bear City Community Services District (BCCSD), and the County of San Bernardino County CSA 53B (CSA 53B). Each of our member agencies operate and maintain their own sewer collection systems and deliver their wastewater to our interceptor system for transport to our wastewater treatment plant.

### Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU)

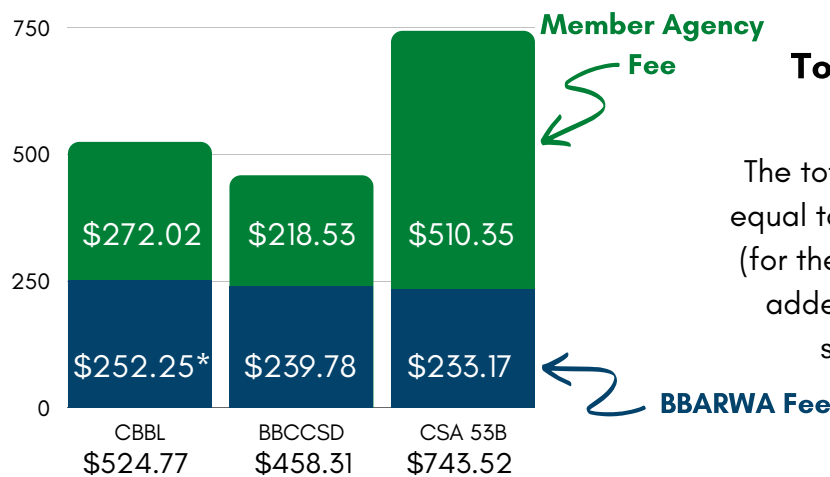
An EDU is a unit of measure for the sewage generated from particular buildings, structures, or uses. One EDU is equal to an approximation of the amount of sewage generated by an average single-family residence. The chart to the right shows the percentage of EDU's per member agency. Our member agencies report a total of 25,287.7 EDUs.



### BBARWA Sewer User Fee (per EDU)

Annual Charges, pursuant to the Agency's Operating Agreement No. 1, are collected annually from the three member agencies based on EDUs and flow per Agency.

CBBL	\$255.75*
BCCSD	\$239.78
CSA 53B	\$233.17



### Total Sewer Fees (per EDU)

The total sewer fees per EDU are equal to BBARWA's Sewer User Fee (for the treatment of wastewater) added to the member agency sewer collection fees.

\*The City of Big Bear Lake passed through a lesser amount than BBARWA's sewer user fee
